2009 CHARDONNAY



Nestled in the Adelaide Hills near Woodside, the Marlborough Park property was established over a century ago as a saddlery and riding school that continue operation today. Randal Tomich has raised vines alongside the horses, and the fruit of these vines has led to a refined new collection of wines. This range bears the name 'Marlborough Park' in homage to their heritage.

Vineyard: The heart of the Hills: 26km due east of the Adelaide CBD. Sustainable organic approach. High altitude: 400m above sea level. Cool-climate, temperature 8-10°C cooler than Adelaide. Slow ripening: crisp, natural acidity, crunchy fresh fruit, complex cool-climate wines.

Region: 100% Adelaide Hills

Harvest: March 2009

Tasting Note: A lovely melon accented nose with grapefruit/lemon notes and blossom. These flavours then explode in the mouth with great flow, some softness and lively acidity.

Accompaniments: Crisp and delicate, this wine is perfect with fish and chips straight from the bag, or try with roasted chicken and sautéed vegetables.
