Nestled in the Adelaide Hills near Woodside, the Marlborough Park property was established over a century ago as a saddlery and riding school that continue operation today. Randal Tomich has raised vines alongside the horses, and the fruit of these vines has led to a refined new collection of wines. This range bears the name 'Marlborough Park' in homage to their heritage.

Vineyard: The heart of the Hills: 26km due east of the Adelaide CBD. Sustainable organic approach. High altitude: 400m above sea level. Cool-climate, temperature 8-10°C cooler than Adelaide. Slow ripening: crisp, natural acidity, crunchy fresh fruit, complex cool-climate wines.

Region: 100% Adelaide Hills

Harvest: March 2009

Tasting Note: Intense and clear tropical nose with asparagus and lime peel notes to balance. The palate reflects this beautifully focused fruit and manages the balance between softness and crisp acidity on the finish.

Accompaniments: For such a fresh and zesty white, try partnering with antipasta such as cold smoked salmon, crusty ciabatta and good extra virgin olive oil.
