2009 was a challenging year, we once again had a heat wave in January. Fortunately in the Adelaide Hills it was in early veraison and we were able to keep the water up to the vines and maintain fresh canopies. This was followed by four weeks of relatively cool weather which slowed ripening resulting in a good year indeed.

Colour: Pale straw

Bouquet: Opens with fleshy pear and nectarine aromas.

Palate: With ripe nectarines and red apples our Pinot Grigio has fruit intensity and a fresh, crisp palate.

The wine finishes full and long, and is designed to be served very chilled. This vibrant wine is perfect for al fresco dining. Serve chilled with grilled fish, salmon or with fresh summer fruits.
