## 2008 ADELAIDE HILLS PINOT NOIR



“Tomich Hill Wines” is a family owned company. Established by the Tomich family with a desire to produce premium cool climate wines, their vineyard is located just north of the township of Woodside in the Adelaide Hills, South Australia.

2008 was a challenging year - we once again had a heat wave in January. Fortunately in the Adelaide Hills it was in early veraison and we were able to keep the water up to the vines and maintain fresh canopies. This was followed by four weeks of relatively cool weather which slowed ripening resulting in a good year indeed.

Grape Varieties: 100% Pinot Noir  
Region: 100% Adelaide Hills

Colour: Early harvest cherry red.

Bouquet: Intense berry and red cherry aroma.

Palate: Vibrant palate of red berry and cherry with subtle hints of dry herbs and silky graceful tannins.

Serve at room temperature. A good all rounder with many food types including quail, duck, turkey and lean red meat.
