## 2008 Reserve Chardonnay



The Tomich Hill Reserve Range represents the very best in viticulture and winemaking, delivering premium wine of wonderful structure and style from our cool climate Adelaide Hills Vineyard.

**Region:** Adelaide Hills  
**Winemaker:** John Tomich / Peter Leske

**Colour:** Pale straw  
**Bouquet:** Full bodied complex creamy palate showing hazelnut and biscuit aromas.  
**Palate:** Full bodied, complex creamy palate with layers of stonefruit and a hint of butter scotch.

**Cellaring:** Enjoy young and fresh, however will increase in depth and complexity over next 2-10 years.

**Food Match:** Enjoy chilled on a summer's evening with a fresh garden salad, delicate fish dishes or grilled chicken.

**Winemaking:** Our Burgundian Chardonnay is a wine of passion. After visiting Burgundy a few years ago, we found a producer in the Puligny-Montrachet region whose wines were outstanding. As a tribute to this winemaker, we purchased the same barrels and made the wine in the same Burgundian style. Fruit was selected from our French clone Chardonnay using only select parcels of fruit. Hand picked in the early morning, wild yeast and malolactic fermentation stirred at 2 week intervals. 30% New French Barrique. 18 months in oak.
