Variety: Pinot Noir
Region: Adelaide Hills
Winemaker: John Tomich / Peter Leske

Colour: Salmon with a hint of pink.
Bouquet: Delicate strawberry and savoury red berry fruit.
Palate: Light bodied with abundant fresh strawberry and raspberry fruit flavours, multi layered and mingling with hints of rich caramel. Shows great length with delicate fruit flavours with an elegant, crisp finish.

Cellaring: Drink fresh.

Food Match: Serve chilled and to be enjoyed on a Summer's evening by the pool. Goes well with summer salads, light fish dishes and chicken salads.

Winemaking: Early morning hand picked Pinot Noir. "Saignée" (bleeding off) of light pink free run juice that underwent a "wild ferment" in old French Barriques with fermentation lasting up to 4 weeks. Classic Vin Gris method of Rosé style winemaking.
